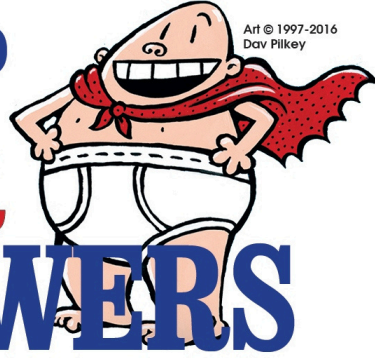

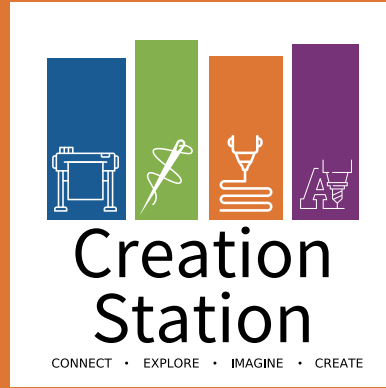
Thank you!

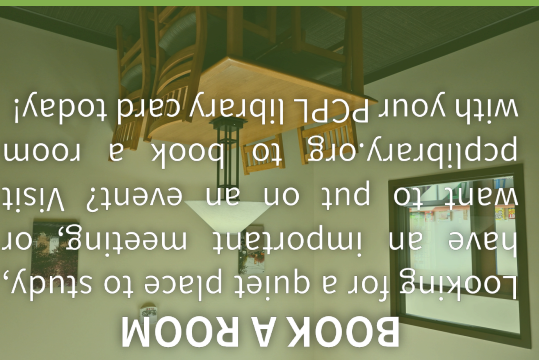
Borrow FREE eBooks, audiobooks, movies, music and more with hoopla and Libby! Just use your PCPL library card and pin to get started.
