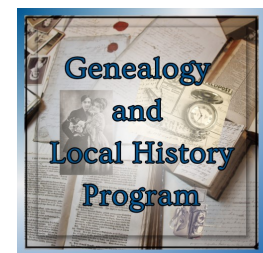

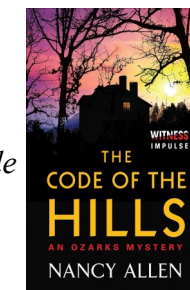
Coffee, Tea, and Conspiracy Book Club adults 18+

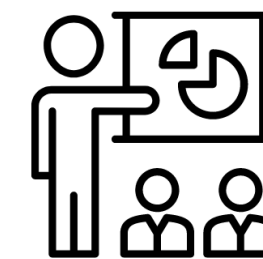
